Trained Patch The Merit Badge Sash is not a part of the uniform itself, but it's often worn over the uniform at a Court of Honor. The Merit Badges should be sewn on the front of the sash as they are earned in neat, even rows of three. Other patches can be sewn on the back of the sash, as long as they are not previously held Badges of Rank or Badges of Office! The image here is not typical by any means. Most Left Pocket scouts have one merit badge sash with just a few.
